NOTES.

1. Passports are valid for five years from the date of issue unless otherwise endorsed. They may be renewed, at the option of the holder, for a further period or periods, from one to five years; provided that the validity of the passport shall not be extended beyond ten years from the original date of issue. If at any time there be no further space for visas, a fresh passport must be obtained. Where the holder is abroad, any application for the renewal or endorsement of this passport should be made to the nearest Australian Migration Officer, Diplomatic or Consular Representative, Government Commissioner or Trade Commissioner. The fee for an Australian passport is £1 and the fee for renewal is 2s. for each year.

2. This passport is only available for travel to the countries named on page 4, but it may be endorsed for additional countries. The possession of a passport so endorsed does not, however, exempt the holder from compliance with any immigration regulations in force in British or foreign countries or from the necessity of obtaining a visa when required.

3. The holder of this passport, if making his or her home, or staying for a prolonged period, in a foreign country, should be registered at the nearest Australian Consulate.

CAUTION.

Being a valuable document this Passport should not be allowed to pass into the possession of any unauthorized person. If lost or destroyed, the fact should be immediately reported to the nearest Commonwealth Migration Officer in Australia, or (if the holder is abroad) to the nearest Australian Migration Officer, Diplomatic or Consular Representative, Government Commissioner or Trade Commissioner.

If this passport is mutilated in any way, or if any endorsement is made by a person other than a duly authorized official, it is liable to be impounded.
